C) Randy's Work

- 1) New MyHeritage Theories of Family Relativity Added 2 new DNA matches which I have entered into my RootsMagic Family Tree program. Reviewed the matches with Shared cM Segments for the two new matches.
- 2) Evaluated my AncestryDNA Chromosome Painting. It is somewhat different from my 23andMe Chromosome Painting. The AncestryDNA painting does not include the small segments of Northern Africa (Chr 6) and Indigenous American (Chr 12) that show on the 23andMe painting.

- 3) Daily Check of DNA Matches looking for new matches, especially with AncestryDNA ThruLines, MyHeritageDNA Theories of Family Relativity, 23andMe high cM matches, and FamilyTreeDNA high cM matches. Current numbers are:
- * AncestryDNA 40,721 matches, 1,778 with 20 cM or more; about 460 with known common ancestors (1-2% wrong);
- * MyHeritage DNA 10,623 matches, 1,601 with 20 cM or more, 17 with Theories of Family Relativity.
- * 23andMe 1,522 matches, 1,500 with 0.29% cM or more. Mo automated matching.
- * FamilyTreeDNA 4,888 matches, 413 with 20 cM or more, no automated matching.
